



2017 Outhouse Classic



Call it whatever you want ... Crapper, Potty, Toilet, Latrine, Comfort Station, Pooper, Outhouse or other names not PG rated ...

Your Outhouse:

- ~ Outhouses may be constructed of any solid materials, but must be structurally sound to not fall apart during race.
 - ~ Outhouses must have four sides, a roof, and doorway. If you choose to have a “door”, it must be secured open during the race.
 - ~ Windows are allowed, but cannot be made of glass.
 - ~ Any number and size of wheels may be used. Bicycle parts are permitted, but NO in-tract bicycles are allowed.
 - ~ Outhouse must not exceed 5 feet in height from the floor to the highest point of the outhouse.
 - ~ Outhouse must have a toilet in some form ... at the least, a hole with a toilet seat (securely attached) that one team member must be seated on during the race. Some form of grab bar must be included for the rider’s safety
 - ~ Outhouse must have a toilet paper holder with a full roll of toilet paper during the race.
 - ~ Each outhouse should have its name or theme displayed on the front or back of the outhouse.
 - ~ Outhouses should resemble an actual outhouse since this is an “outhouse race”.
- *** For construction design ideas, simple google “outhouse races” for lots of fun pictures & videos.

Your Team

- ~ Each team consists of 2 pushers or pullers, one rider and may include two (2) alternates – maximum of five (5) team members with one member seated in the outhouse during the race.
- ~ Teams are encouraged to dress to fit the theme of the outhouse (this is a “family” event – please dress tastefully).
- ~ While not required, we encourage participants to wear helmets during the race for their personal safety.
- ~ Outhouse team members must be at least 18 years of age and sign a safety / liability release the day of the race.

Rules of the Race

*** **The first rule of consideration is SAFETY for the racers and the public. Use good common sense based on safety in your outhouse construction, team members costumes, and in racing.**

- ~ Race will take place in “heats” with 2 outhouses racing each time. Heat competitors are determined by a number drawing and placed in brackets.
- ~ Teams must push or pull your entry ... absolutely NO pedals, motors, or mechanization of any kind.
- ~ Team pushes/pulls outhouse down a short course, member sitting on the toilet gets out and switches the roll of toilet paper from inside their outhouse to the one at the end of the course, gets back inside, and team pushes/pulls the outhouse back to the beginning line.
- ~ The 2 teams with the fastest time during their heat will then race each other for the Championship.

Prizes

- ~ Custom trophies and cash prizes awarded as follows:
 - \$100 – 1st Place “The Big Dipper”
 - \$ 75 – 2nd Place “The #2”
 - \$ 50 – 3rd Place “Little Stinker”
